Adelaide Velo-city Global 2014 is the world's premier international cycling planning conference.

This special four-day event will not only celebrate cycling, but offers the chance for delegates from around the world to discuss ways to create and sustain cycling-friendly cities.

Since 1980 conferences have been held in Copenhagen, Paris, Dublin, Brussels, Barcelona, Munich, Montreal, Vancouver and Vienna. Adelaide Velo-city Global 2014 will be the first time the event has left the northern hemisphere.

The ECF established the Velo-city Global conference series in 2010 to answer the growing demand for expertise in cycling from cities. Velo-city Global aims to achieve contributions and participants from six continents. The program and structure of the conference are also developed using a global context. This is different from the Velo-city conference series. Velo-city is developed with an international perspective but has a main focus on Europe or the country hosting the conference in that particular year.

- What cultural transformation is required?


